Words Matter

- survivor ≠ victim

victim: what was done in a moment in time

survivor: a person that endures, hopes, moves forward, recovers

- legal ≠ ethical or safe

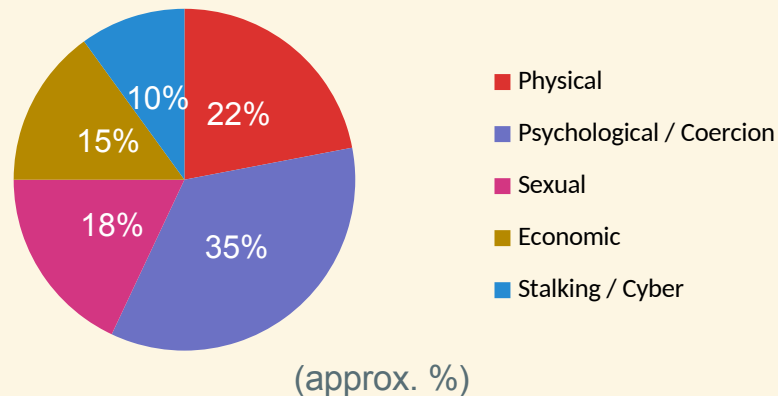
legal can still pose a risk and/or create harm

- abuse ≠ physical violence

abuse is about power and control, not just physical harm

Too many personal details openly and legally available online:

- Current & Previous addresses
- Phone numbers
- Relatives and (ex-)spouses
- Property ownership
- Court records
- Voter registration records
- Financial & Commercial Data
- Professional licensing databases

Protective actions:

- Data Broker Removal
- Address Confidentiality Programs
- Court Record Sealing
- Reduce Institutional Exposure
- Be Careful With Forwarding Addresses

Cheating by the numbers...

One of the unpleasant truths most married individuals are blissfully ignorant of is the surprisingly high occurrence of infidelity & extramarital affairs. According to a study by Joan D. Abarwood & Limor Schwartz, published in 2002, by the Journal of Couple & Relationship Therapy, 45-55% of married women and 50-60% of married men engage in extramarital sex at some time or another during their relationship. If that is not alarming enough, another study puts the average nonpaternity rate at above 3.3%, or in other words, 33 children in every thousand are not fathered by the man everybody thinks they are...

The past two decades has made infidelity more accessible than ever mostly because of the ascent of two major disruptive technologies: online social networks and mobile phones.

Up to 90% of marital affairs may include the use of a mobile phone or email as a preferred means for communication.

Good news is that technology can also be used to detect & reveal infidelity.

If it's designed to run covertly, it's stalkerware.

Use Kaspersky's Tinycheck to catch unwanted traffic from your device.

Get screenshots or recordings of the stalkerware operating on your device. Use another device to do so.

Factory reset your device.

Use a dumbphone.

Run malware detector.

Safe Houses & Shelter Consulting

Shelter

- Aiming for Confidentiality

Less secretive and can often be community supported

- Structured

Typically run by organisations or government programs

- Support-Service Focused

Provides housing alongside services like counseling, legal assistance & child support

Safe House

- Aiming for Concealment

Locations are often undisclosed and intentionally difficult to identify

- Designed for High-Risk Situations

Protecting survivors facing stalking, lethal threats, trafficking

- Controlled Operations

Movement and communication are tightly restricted

Real question: “Will I be safe in this place?”
